


Syphilis Treatment Singapore- Why Timely Care Is Crucial

- 3. Latent Stage: No symptoms appear; however the bacteria lie dormant in some internal organs.
- 4. Tertiary Stage: Severe medical disorders, including heart diseases and neurological disorders and even cause blindness if not treated in a timely manner.

Why Get Syphilis Treated Early on in Singapore

1. Prevents Severe Disease Complications

Getting syphilis under proper treatment on time is primarily due to the prevention of complications. Syphilis, at its early stage, can be fully and effectively cured with antibiotics or penicillin.
